SIGNIFICANCE OF HAJJ & ITS MEANINGFUL BENEFITS

Allah Ta'ala savs in the Noble Ouran: "And announce to humanity, (O Ibrahim), the pilgrimage, and people will come from every part of the world by every means of transport - so that they may witness the benefits for them ..." (Surah Hajj - Verse 27)

Hajj is actually a means of continuing and reviving the remembrance of that worship which has been part of every religion from the time of Hazrat Adam and Hazrat Ibrahim القلية إ

In all acts of worship including Hajj, there is the outward act and an inner deeper meaning. Hereunder some of these great benefits of hajj are mentioned;

Hajj as a picture of death

A person leaves his home, bids farewell to near and dear ones and departs on the journey alone. As how he boards the plane as a conveyance, in death his conveyance will be the bier carried on people's shoulders.

Just as how family and friends can only accompany the Haii to the airport, friends and family can only accompany one in death to the edge of the grave. In death, a person leaves behind his home, family and undertakes this journey alone.

A Haii wears two white sheets to cover his body. In death a person is also wrapped in sheets of the Kafan which serve as his garment.

The greatest comfort a Haji enjoys in Haji comes from the money and provisions, which he carries with him before leaving. Likewise, the greatest comfort one enjoys in the life after death is that which comes from the good deeds, he performed before his death.

International Conference

There are times when different classes of people gather to dialogue, share information and discuss possible solutions. This is what happens in Hajj where representatives from all over the globe, from all spheres of life and from all ranks gather at Makkah for this great annual international conference.

Networking

What better place can there be for networking than at Makkah at the time of



Minimum age of the Qurbani animal

Among the specifications of a Qurbani animal, is the age of the animal. Just as the animal must be from the category of animals permitted for Qurbani, it must also be of the prescribed age.

Should an animal not meet the age requirement, it will not be permitted for Qurbani. Such Qurbani will not be valid, and will have to be repeated.

The age requirements are as follows:	
CAMELS	5 years old or more
CATTLE	2 years old or more
GOAT AND SHEEP*	1 year old or more

*If the sheep is six months and older, but it is so healthy and well-built that it resembles a one-year-old, then such a sheep will be permitted for Qurbani. The way to determine this is if the 6-month old sheep is placed within a year-old flock, it does not appear smaller than the rest of the flock. This age concession has been granted **only for sheep**, not for goats or any other Qurbani animal.

If the sheep is younger than six months, then even though it resembles a one-year-old sheep it will **NOT** be valid for Qurbani. The concession strictly applies to sheep that are 6 months or older.



PHYSICAL & MENTAL DISABILITES

Aphysical disability refers to an impairment or limitation to a person's physical functioning. Many physical disabilities are visible or noticeable, e.g. someone with a mobility challenge in a wheelchair, or a visually impaired person using an aide; however, there are many that are not.

Mental disabilities are usually given less importance, and suffer higher stigma. They can refer to certain psychiatric illnesses and intellectual disorders. If a person wears clothes in Ihram that have been washed with normal washing powder by someone else by hand or in a washing machine is there any penalty?

Once a person has entered the state of Ihram through intention/talbiyya, the laws of Ihram become applicable. Accordingly, if the Ihram was washed with scented soap/washing powder prior to entering into Ihram, then that will be permissible and there will be no penalty.

Is Safa and Marwa regarded as part of the Masiid in Makkah Shareef? If so is a woman who is not in a state of reading allowed to sit there?

No. Based on our understanding this area it is not regarded as part of the Masjid. Thus, if there is a need then she may sit in this area in the state of Haidh provided she takes precaution in not inconveniencing others.

I missed my Jumah Salah due to exams - Do I need to pay Fidya?

There is no Fidya for missing Jumuah Salah. One should not miss Jumuah Salah. Arrangements should be made to be free during the time of Jumuah Salah to be able to make Jumuah. Alternately try

and perform the Jumuah Salah at a later venue.

However, in the unfortunate circumstances where Jumuah Salah is missed, then abundant Taubah and Istighfaar should be made and Zuhr Salah should be performed.

Is it permissible to slaughter a castrated animal for Qurbani?

The Qurbani of a castrated animal is valid. In sheep and goats such animals are even preferred.

Is it permissible to do gurbani of one sheep or one share of a cow with multiple intentions

Eg: for yourself, Nabi & and the marhooms? Or does your gurbani which is for yourself have to be done with only one intention?

If it is a Wajib Qurbani then you cannot make multiple intentions. One may make multiple intentions in a Nafl Ourbani.

If my Ourbani is done for me by a third person, is it Mustahab that I must still refrain from cutting or trimming my hair or nails?

Yes. It will still be Mustahab.

The "Fast" of Eid-al-Adha

It is Mustahab (preferable) for the person making Ourbani to abstain from eating anything on the Day of Eid from the morning till his animal is slaughtered. It is preferred to partake of the Qurbani meat first, before eating anything else.

(Ahmad, Tirmidhi)

NB. This is a Mustahab (optional and rewarding) practice - there is no compulsion. However, we should all endeavour to practice and reap the benefit.

We purchased a Qurbani animal to slaughter on behalf of the Marhoomeen which was neither theirs or their Wajib Qurbani. The animal died a day before Qurbani. Is there a need to purchase another animal again and make Ourbani on their behalf?

Since the Qurbani was supposed to be nafl (optional) it is not necessary to replace the animal as in the case of a Wajib Qurbani.

Is it encouraged to offer a Qurbani (Sacrifice) on behalf of Rasulullah #

After one completes the compulsory Qurbani, and one still has the means, it is recommended to perform Qurbani on behalf of Rasulullah & as well. One may also include the Sahabah &, the entire Ummah, the Prophets and all those living or deceased relatives, friends and teachers who have conveyed Deeni knowledge or been a cause of benefit to one in the same Nafl or additional Nafl Ourbani animals.

Hazrat Abu Talha \$\iiii has related that Rasulullah \$\iiiis sacrificed one ram and while sacrificing the other he said, "This is on behalf of every one of my Ummah who believed in me and testified (to my prophethood)." (Tabrani)
